Learning Objectives

After this lesson, students will be able to:

- Apply established preservation care and handling principles in creating staff and user education programs in libraries and archives.
- Identify the fundamental principles of holdings and stacks maintenance programs and use this information to improve physical storage environment for collections.
- Determine which protective enclosures are appropriate for specific formats and collections.
- Make observations about different storage facilities and communicate these observations clearly in both written and verbal form.
- Communicate the concerns and issues involved in designing and mounting exhibitions.
